

My name is James Luker, I have been practising as a farrier for several years and have kept horses all my life. I first saw Paddy before he received this treatment. He was very crippled with pain and didn't want to move, even when chased constantly with a lunge whip. When I watched him walk and get into a trot he was lame and extremely stiff in all of his joints. I proceeded to flex his knee and fetlock joints and he had limited mobility in each one. His back was dipped and even when standing, he had a pained expression. Areas of his coat, mane and tail were rubbed down to skin that was covered with scabs. I was asked what I would think if Paddy became like a normal horse by the next time that I saw him – I just laughed because I considered that to be impossible.

On my return after Paddy's treatment I was stunned. Here was Paddy - a different horse - charging around the field, freely and willingly, without being forced or provoked in any way. All I could do was nod and shake my head – everything about this horse has changed: he has normal skin and new, thick coat, his back is not dipped, he certainly isn't lame or stiff and when I flexed his joints they had the mobility of a normal horse. This is really exciting to see- I'm telling everyone!
